Construction of the school

The school expansion is concluded with the construction of the boundary wall to safeguard the school going children from outside interference and making the environment safe and secure for all. There are total three classrooms and three toilets facilities separate for boys and girls.

School function



School do undertakes all function at their premises to celebrate the national program of Independence Day on 15th August 2015.

All the school students and the village heads were present for the program. Grounds were specially prepared for the occasion and accordingly the arrangements were done. National anthem was sung and later on sweets were distributed among the children. This program allows the local village community to see their coming generation enthusiasm for their national duty also.

School Education

The school education care takes not only the basic education courses for the children in their own language in which the students are from. There are three teachers and 35 students at presently in the school. The uphill task of caretaking the interest of the primitive children who can grasp the subject in their own context and are able to relate it. Few general subjects like Maths and science are bit hard and needs more resources and strength. There are different methodology applied from time and again to update both the students and the staff for self-review and assessment like the Diagnosing student learning issues, Providing feedback to students on their learning, Informing parents about their child's learning and Planning next steps in instruction

School also provides extension services to the village community like parent's teachers



meeting, awareness creation on rights and entitlements, tapping of government schemes and linkages with the government departments. Women groups are formed which are better known as SHG as they are the only platform for collective women to take their voice at the gram sabha level. Focus on agriculture from traditional to modern methodology is also imparted to the men groups to get better yield from their field.
